Research and Collection data in Andong Communities

General Operations: According to the research, Andong village is located in Sangkat Kork roka, Khan Prek Phnov. These communities are mixed from three different communities such as Building (Sambok Chab), Beong Salang, and Phnom Penh Thmei. People in Andong one and Andong two were moved on March 23, 2006 and later on other communities were moved to Andong village on June, 6th 2006 after Anlong Kghnan and now it is called Sen Sok communities which were moved on November 31, 2001.

Firstly, there were 93 community families in Beong Salang were moved to Andong on March 23, 2006 and secondly, there were over 700 families from Sambok Chab were moved to Andong on **June 6, 2006**, and lastly there were 117 families from Phnom Penh Thmei were moved to Andong on June 6, 2006 too.

In fact, there was only one community called Sambok Chab after being moved from the three above in 2006, but after being moved and mixed three more communities, the numbers of people had increased dramatically. Later on these were called Andong communities which totally had 1545 families that are equal to over 4000 people. Lastly on March 19, 2012 Andong was separated into 6 communities by city governor, Kep Chutema because he thought it was easy to control and to manage. Finally, Andong communities were separated, changed and located in Sangkat Kouk Roka, Khan Prek Phnove on 9 of June, 2014 that led by new Khan governor Mr. Sok Sambath.

All the six communities are First Andong Community, Second Andong Community, Third Andong Community, Fourth Andong Community, Fifth Andong Community, and Sixth Andong Community. There are different in numbers of people and families as the following.



I. First Andong Community (Andong 1)

This community was moved from Phnom Penh Thmei, near Phsa Deihuy on June 6, 2006 and is located nearby Chhuk Va high school which has total 58 families, 273 people, 127 males, 146 females, and 35 under aged of 18 year- old people and it is on the south of People Care in Learning (PCL) called Andong market. Their living standards are in poor lives because some of them are factory workers, junk collectors, motor taxi drivers, vendors, construction workers, and the rests stay at homes to look after their children, or some are jobless. A few children were sent to **Vun Kvang**, an organization which has supported from South Korea and has opened since 2009. Now it has 66 kids from the age of nine months until forty months, and other kids are sent other organizations such as Friends, School of Hope Cambodia, CIAI, DAIL Community, Orphan Disable Youth and Poor Women Trainings Organization, Development People in Cambodia.

- II. Second Andong Community (Andong 2)

This community was moved from Beong Salang on March 23, 2006 and is located nearby Chhuk Va high school too. It is in the south of People Care in Learning market (PCL) and next to Andong 1. It is a good example community for other communities because most of the people have house plans, with public electricity and water, concrete enough water pipe. Their living conditions are in poor lives because some of them are factory workers, junk collectors, motor taxi drivers, vendors, construction workers, and the rests stay at homes to look after their children, or some are jobless and play cards. This community has total 46 families and 173 people.

However, the rest do not have house plans because they are anarchy families. Their children are sent to school which nearby and other sent to other organizations such as Friends, School of Hope Cambodia, CIAI, DAIL Community, Orphan Disable Youth and Poor Women Trainings Organization, Development People in Cambodia.

Their children are sent to school which nearby and other sent to other organizations such as Friends, School of Hope Cambodia, CIAI, DAIL Community, Orphan Disable Youth and Poor Women Trainings Organization, Development People in Cambodia. It has 262 families, 832 people, 355 females and 477 males.

IV. Fourth Andong Community (Andong 4)

This community is located in the west of People for Care and Learning (PCL) market and is the north of third and fifth communities. It has a lot of slums and it will be moved around May 2015 to the new location. People's living conditions are poor because some of them work as junk collectors, motor taxi drivers, factory workers, construction workers and the rests stay at home to look after their children or sometimes they play cards. This has no concrete water pipes and they have problems during rainy season. This community has 297 families, 1070 people, 510 females, 560 males, and there are 597 people over the age of 18, there are 237 people from the age of 7 up-to 17 years old. Their children are sent to school which nearby and other sent to other organizations such as Friends, School of Hope Cambodia, CIAI, DAIL Community of Cambodia, Orphan Disable Youth and Poor Women Trainings Organization, Development People in Cambodia. It has 297 families, 1070 people, 510 females and 560 males.

This community is located in the west of People Care in learning market (PCL) and has better living condition because it got the helps from PLC, People Care in Learning to build concrete houses and has better concrete water pipe. People, who live in Fifth Andong Community generally work for factories, are construction workers, motor taxi drivers, vendors, junk collectors and the others are housewives. Their children are sent to school which nearby and other sent to other organizations such as Friends, School of Hope Cambodia, CIAI, DAIL Community, Orphan Disable Youth and Poor Women Trainings Organization, Development People in Cambodia. It has 264 families, 745 people, 369 females, and 376 males, 285 houses, 8 free pieces of land; there are 537 people from the age of 18 up-to, 86 people from the age of 7 to 17 years old.

VI. Sixth Andong Community (Andong 6)

People in this community were moved from Beong Salang, Building, Sam Buk Chab, and Phnom Penh Thmei. After being moved, they live and stay on the canals and on the surface and slums and it is located in south of People for Care and learning (PCL) market which is next to Andong 3 between Andong 1 and Andong 2. If we go through to this community, we must walk across the wooden bridge which was built on water surface and look dirty around or under the cottages. It can be dangerous for the children who live there because the kids can fall down easily from their houses or from the wooden bridge. In addition, each house has no concrete water pipes to rescue dirty water. During the rainy season it can be flooded into their houses and smell bad and look dirty. Their living condition is poor lives because some of them are factory workers, junk collectors, motor taxi drivers, vendors, construction workers, and the rests stay at homes to look after their children, or some are jobless and play cards. As a matter of fact, people and children are in bad condition in health because of lacking of being hygienic. Moreover, this community will be moved to the new location with Andong 4 around May 2015, according to Mr. Pove Buntheoun, community chief said. It has 270 families, 1126 people, 599 females, and 527 males, 660 people from 18 up to. Their children are sent to school which nearby and other sent to other organizations such as Friends, School of Hope Cambodia, CIAI, DAIL Community, Orphan Disable Youth and Poor Women Trainings Organization, Development People in Cambodia.

In conclusion, according to the interview with community chiefs, some children from the ages of 6 years old up to 17 years old, and some people from the ages of 18 up to 45 years old said that they need more food, clothes, education, job opportunities, health, and shelters, especially Andong 6 and 4 they need more helps urgently from other organizations and the government of Cambodia because their living conditions are not good with both children and elderly. They live on the dirty water and sometimes some children fall into the water. They look so thin and pale with lacking of food and lacking of hygiene.
