The Slum in Stung Mean Chang, Phnom Penh Cambodia

We dropped off some rice and some medical funds. We are also hunting down some real estate to start a ministry there that will educate the people who live in the Slum. This is being done with "The Well of Life Foundation". For \$600(US) we bought 1 ton, 50 kilograms of rice that will feed approximately 100 families for 3 days (4-8 members per family, Approximately 800 people). It was a lot easier this time as now we have local pastors who help with the distribution and monitoring the families with ration books.













To me, this is the most amazing concept. These people walk on the garbage with their bare feet. They walk on broken glass, sharp objects, it's just amazing.





And this is one toughest kids you'll ever

meet on this earth. He works in the garbage for about 4, 5, 8 hours a day in his bare feet in 100 degree heat for about \$1 dollar a day.

And how about water? Do you ever take it for granted? This is the water supply for about 800 people. About 800 people drink out of this one cup!!! Imagine living like this. And I can tell you how grateful these people are for this water tap. Before this tap, don't ask!
