They contained Soap, Toothbrush, Toothpaste, and 10 noodle soups.




 Most of these people in the Stueng Meun Cheng Slum do not have these Basic Necessities.








## We had the families and the children's names organized ahead of time, here are there names.


#### But once lined, up the process began

And we then distributed 50 mosquito nets, mostly for families. The nets are large enough for about 2 - 4 people.





